

Chromebook Collection

Spring 2017

With the end of the year approaching, HHS will be collecting all school-issued Chromebooks for the summer.



For convenience, Chromebooks for **Grades 9 & 10** will be collected during a special **Homeroom/Advisory on Monday, June 19**. This is the day before exams, and we anticipate that most students will be done with their Chromebooks by this date. Students are expected to return the Chromebook, along with its case and its charger. (If you received your charger in a brown cardboard box, you do *not* need to return the box.)

However, if a student needs more time with the Chromebook, due to special preparations for exams, he or she may turn in the Chromebook to the **library on either of the exam days** (Tuesday, June 20 and Wednesday, June 21).

Students in **Grade 11** can return borrowed Chromebooks to the **library any time from Monday June 19 through Wednesday June 21**.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What if I lost my Chromebook, charger, or case?

A: The replacement cost for each of these items is listed in the box to the right. You can bring a check for the missing item to the main office. The check will be held for 30 days, in case you find the missing items during the summer. Missing Chromebooks will be disabled remotely.

Replacement Costs

- Chromebook \$200
- Charger \$20
- Protective case \$25

Q: Will I get the same Chromebook back in the fall?

A: Yes, the plan is for you to get back the same Chromebook you turned in. However, if the HHS technology staff finds issues with your Chromebook, it might be repaired, replaced, or wiped clean. You should transfer any important files stored on the Chromebook into your Google Drive before you turn in the Chromebook.
