## **Who is the PIT Crew?**

- PIT Crew students also know how to refer issues that are too complex for them to Tom or Brandon

## **Who does the PIT Crew help?**

The PIT Crew is available to help any HHS faculty, staff, and students with technology and audio-visual issues

## **Does this mean I have to use the PIT Crew for tech support now?**

No, the PIT Crew is designed to give you and the school more tech support options. We would like to have students with tech issues use the PIT Crew Help Desk. However, as teachers, you have *special VIP status*, and are still allowed to contact Brandon or Tom directly like you always have done.
